

Please help to organize support for this slate of Party's legislative priorities: You can easily familiarize yourself with the State's website capitol.hawaii.gov Contact information is given for all members of the House and Senate. Pay particular emphasis on contacting the Representative and Senator from your district as they always have a particular interest in hearing from their constituents.

TRACKING: To track bills using the legislature's website, go to capitol.hawaii.gov and click on measure tracking. If you haven't already set up an account, follow the prompts there to do so. Once you are logged in, the measure tracking, hearing notification, and submit testimony buttons will be orange.

1) In "**measure tracking**" fill in the text box (e.g. "min wage") and click on "create list". Then, next to the list name click on "show list" and enter bill numbers into the next text box. (If you don't know bill numbers, you can do key word searches on capitol.hawaii.gov) Next to bill numbers on the list, you can type notes on each bill if you want, or not. Then to generate a list of bills with status information from that list, click on "generate report." This is an efficient way to routinely check status on all bills you are tracking.

2) In "**hearing notification**", enter the bill number(s) in the text box under "subscribe by measure"- this will ensure that copies of hearing notices relevant to your bills are emailed to you.
